Thank you for your interest in Project Mañana International. Project Mañana is a community-based development ministry in Santiago, Dominican Republic and has ministry sites in the communities of Villa Gonzalez & Cienfuegos. We also have discipleship ministry taking place in fifteen Dominican prisons. Project Mañana focuses on Discipleship through six Organizational Projects: Education Project, Nutrition Project, Clean Water Project, Timothy Project, Prison Project and the Princess Project. Summer interns play a critical role supporting both staff and short-term teams.

- Daily activities can be adjusted, as needed, to avoid large, crowded areas. Masks are currently required in the Dominican Republic, and gloves as necessary
- Training is given to all visitors on best practices and safety protocol
